Why do we do RMs?

- Legislative Authority: “Because Congress told us to!”
- NTSB Recommendations
- DOT Priorities
- FMCSA Priorities





5-YR Rulemaking Plan

The Plan (CY2011-2015) is intended to:

- Be an Internal Management Tool for coordination among the various offices
- Communicate to the public our highest regulatory priorities and receive their input
- Be aligned with FMCSA's three core principles: Raise the Bar; Maintain High Safety Standards; and Remove High Risk





Process for Developing the Plan

Based on:

- RMs already underway or have Regulatory Identification Numbers Drawn
- Brainstorming interviews with Agency Personnel at HQ and in the Field
- Review of existing regulations (new E.O. 13563)





Process (cont'd)

- Obtain approval by OST
- MCSAC Participation/input
- Publish Federal Register Notice of Availability; requests for comments
- Incorporate public comments and finalize the rule.
- Available on FMCSA web site.
