

On March 30, 2012, BAJA EXPRESS TRANSPORTES SA de CV was granted a certificate of registration for Provisional Operating Authority (Provisional Operating Authority) to participate in the Cross-Border Long-Haul Pilot Program (Pilot Program) authorizing transportation in the United States beyond U.S. municipalities and commercial zones on the U.S.-Mexico border. Operations under the Provisional Operating Authority are subject to subpart B of Part 385 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR §§ 385.101 – 385.119) and the terms and conditions of the Pilot Program. You are reminded that while BAJA EXPRESS TRANSPORTES SA de CV remains in the safety monitoring program operating under Provisional Operating Authority, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) will continue to monitor your operating procedures to ensure compliance with all applicable U.S. safety regulations and the specific requirements of the Pilot Program.

Additionally, should you commit one or more of the violations described in 49 CFR § 385.105, you may be subject to an additional compliance review or required to submit a written response demonstrating corrective action. Failure to respond within 30 days to an Agency demand for a written response demonstrating corrective action will result in a suspension of your Provisional Operating Authority for the Pilot Program and may also affect your ability to operate under any OP-2 authority in the commercial zone.
